- 4. The ratio of red to blue counters is 4:6. What fraction of the counters are red?
- 5. A recipe uses flour and sugar in the ratio 2 : 5. If you use 100g of sugar, how much flour is needed?
- 6. Simplify the ratio 25: 100.
- 7. Two numbers are in the ratio 7 : 3. If the larger number is 56, what is the smaller number?
- 8. Split 80 apples between Tom and Jerry in the ratio 1:3.
- 9. The ratio of cats to dogs at a shelter is 5 : 2. If there are 20 dogs, how many cats are there?
- 10. A car travels petrol and electric in the ratio 3 : 1. If it travels 300 miles using petrol, how many miles does it travel using electric?
